(Wakasa Town)

9 Nihonkai Sakanamachi
(Tsuruga City)

This lively fish market offers fresh seafood dishes from the Sea of Japan.



3 Hama no Shiki (Obama City)



Showcasing the best of Obama, this restaurant offers the city's natural flavors in front of Wakasa Bay.



8 GOKOICHI CYCLING
(Mihama Town)

Cycling around the Mikata Five Lakes is safe and exhilarating even for beginners.



10 Tsuruga Kombu Oboroya (Tsuruga City)

Tsuruga is one of the largest producers of Oboro kombu in Japan. Here, you can try your hand at kombu shaving, just like an artisan.



4 Miketsukuni Wakasa Obama Food Culture Museum (Obama City)



Take part in a hands-on chopstick polishing workshop unique to Obama, the largest producer of chopsticks in Japan.



7 Fukui Prefectural Varve Museum (Wakasa Town)



Explore the Earth's records woven by nature in this museum, a rarity in the world.



5 Rainbow Line Mountain Peak Park (Mihama Town)

This park presents spectacular 360-degree panoramic views of the Mikata Five Lakes, the Sea of Japan, and the sky. You can also enjoy eating photogenic sweets here.



6 Wakasa Mikata Kirara Onsen Suigekka (Wakasa Town)

On the shore of Lake Suigetsu, one of the Mikata Five Lakes, this resort hotel features gourmet food and stunning views.



11 Keihi Jingu Shrine
(Tsuruga City)

This shrine is familiarly known as "Keisan" by locals. The 11-meter grand torii gate, which is designated as an Important Cultural Property, is spectacular.
